Dubbo's new Surgical Unit opened its doors on Tuesday 20th March to patients and staff following an extensive planning, design and construction period. Before the move, local Wiradjuri Elder, Lewis Burns conducted a smoking ceremony that was attended by Member for Dubbo Troy Grant, WNSW Local Health District Chief Executive Scott McLachlan, hospital staff and the project team.

The new open, bright Surgical Unit features 34 beds, 14 single rooms and 11 unique carer's zones designed to allow carers or family members to stay overnight to support patients after surgery if it's suitable to do so.
